Qualité FLE

Starting this year, the French government has committed to a quality assurance process for FLE (French as a foreign language) centers in France.

More than 100,000 people come to France every year to take French courses. Nearly 300 various types of centers (public, private, associations) offer their services.

That is why the Ministries of Higher Education and Research, Foreign and European Affairs, and Culture and Communication have decided to establish a certification system for the French as a foreign language centers located in France. To that end, a “Quality label for French as a foreign language” has been created. This process was designed by the government to identify, recognize and promote schools whose language programs and services meet the required quality standards.

The Centre International d’Etudes Pédagogiques (CIEP), a national public administrative body associated with the Ministry of National Education, is responsible for implementing this certification system.
